#### Director's Note

We live in a time of cultural separation; we live in a time where violence and cruel words feel normative. I find myself asking: 'What can I hold on to when such heaviness infiltrates my worldview?' Les Misérables provides answers: The story propels us into a world where its characters experience unbearable hardship and injustice; who make difficult decisions to simply stay alive and even some who sacrifice themselves so that others may be free. It serves as a mirror, reminding us all that the journey of life presents us all--sooner or later--with challenges that can eclipse happiness and joy. And yet, two of Les Misérables' final lyrics are "To love another person is to see the face of God," and "Tomorrow Comes." It looks beyond the eclipse and sees the light: it provides an anthem of hope, staking the claim that loving and empathizing with our fellow travelers--whether strangers or family, foe or friend--is soul medicine for us all.
